"Put on then, as God's chosen ones, holy and beloved, compassionate hearts, kindness, humility, meekness, and patience, bearing with one another and, if one has a complaint against another, forgiving each other; as the Lord has forgiven you, so you also must forgive." – Colossians 3:12-13

I've been a part of the George Volunteer Fire Department for a little while now. I joined almost a year ago and have enjoyed being a part of this organization. When a call comes in, it's imperative to put our protective equipment on as fast as possible. Without the proper equipment, we wouldn't be able to help others, we wouldn't be protected from the fire, and we'd be putting ourselves and others in danger. But because I have the proper equipment—and the training on how to use it effectively—I can be a contributing member of the fire department. I can be identified as a volunteer firefighter.

The same is true for believers. Last month, we looked at some of the equipment and tools that we need to discard. This is our sin nature—the ways we approach and cope with life that are against God and His Word. These tools are not worth keeping around. As believers, we are called to use different equipment—equipment that will protect us against the schemes of the devil, will help us live out God's call in our lives, and will be a help to ourselves and others. Some of these tools are shared with us in the verses above.

As believers—as God's chosen ones—we are to put on certain clothing, certain equipment. Compassionate hearts refers to extending mercy to other people. We should show sympathy for others and consider their needs above ours. Kindness is the Spirit-produced goodness which meets needs in God's way and in God's timing. Kindness is considerate of and generous towards others. Humility loves God and others more than self. It is the laying aside of our wants and rights so that we can lift up others. Meekness means having the willingness to give way when no principle is at stake but only personal opinion or desire. It is Christian courtesy instead of rudeness and harshness. Closely connected, patience is having the ability to forbear without getting upset. It is the resolute refusal to retaliate instead of using our old tools of pursing revenge and retribution.


These tools are followed up with how to put them into practice. We need to bear with each other and forgive one another. We used our old tools to give up on people and to hate when others fail us. Our new tools are meant to extend favor and grace—to pardon any offense as Christ has pardoned our offenses. Just as we couldn't earn our forgiveness from Christ, others can't earn our forgiveness. We must forgive as we have been forgiven.

This is just a snapshot of the tools we now have because of Christ. This is the equipment we are meant to be clothed in as we go out into the world. This month, be encouraged to put this on daily. Put it on to show you are a part of God's people. Put it on to help others. Put it on to protect yourself.
